



Massachusetts laws

- Strict prohibitions under Liquor Control Act
- "Happy Hour" regulation limits practices such as drink discounts, free beverages, contests with awards as drinks, etc
- "Private function" events must meet the specific criteria to include host, access, records, etc



OMNI PARKER HOUSE

- 14 function rooms on 2nd floor that could be used as hospitality rooms are available from Aug 27 to Sep 1 -\$200 per room
- 5 premium one bedroom suites (available for TAGs or state VIPs)
- 15% discount on 2020 food and beverage menu pricing (no outside food or beverage)
- Bar and food service will be available until 1am. 1 bartender required per 100 guests, \$175 for 5 hours and cashier (\$150)required for cash bar.
- Hotel will furnish hospitality function rooms with existing furniture (ie tables and chairs) inventory at not extra charge (additional furnishings and televisions would need to be rented)










Assign unpaid members to board officers

- Ex. 1000 unpaid / 15 members on board 67 calls each.
 - Larger states reach out for volunteers to assist
- Hold each board member accountable.
- Incentivize production. ie: gift cards, etc.

Encourage telethons

- Member hosts event at their house
- Members get together for a few hours after work
- Builds Comradery
