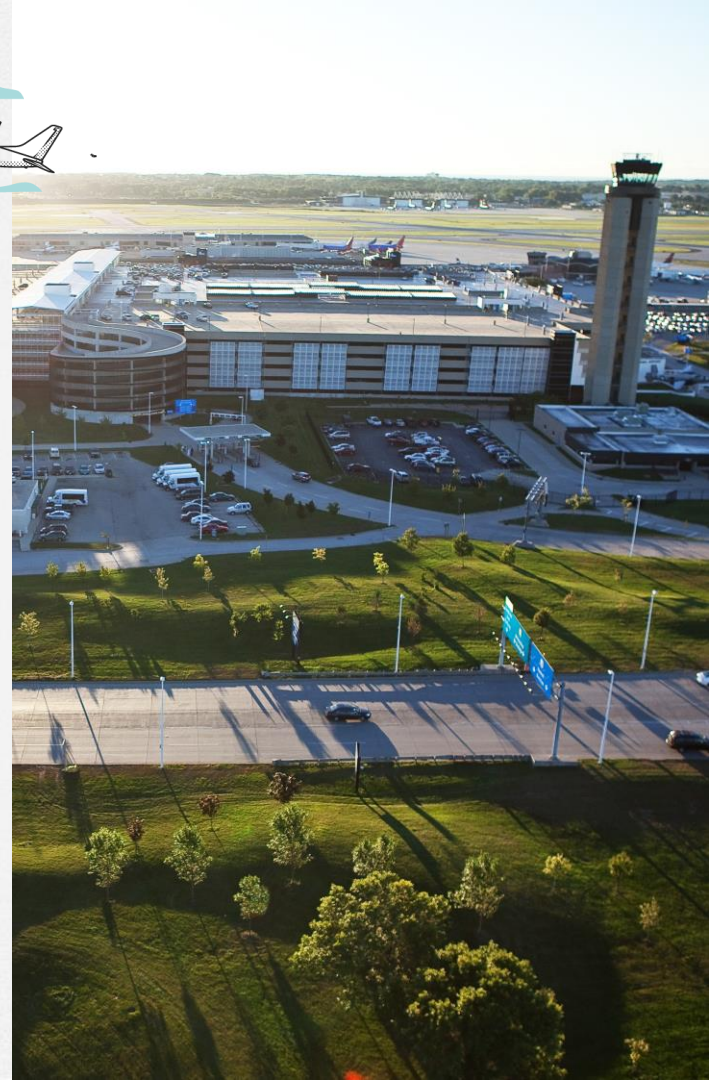
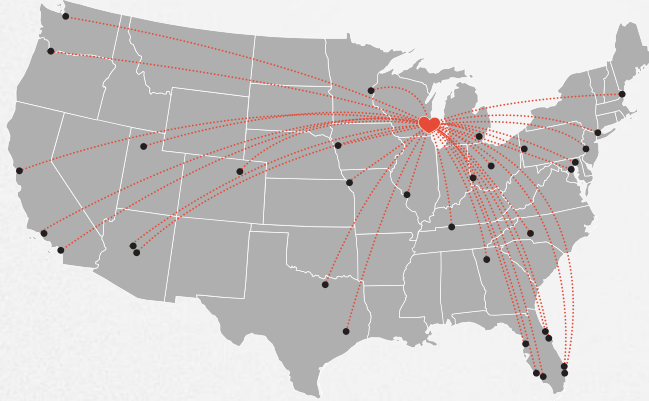


Milwaukee Mitchell International Airport

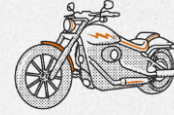
Milwaukee Mitchell International Airport (MKE) is just eight miles from downtown offering non-stop flights from over 45 cities and one-stop flights from 160 cities.

Amtrak Hiawatha Service

- 190-space parking lot that can also be transformed into outdoor event space



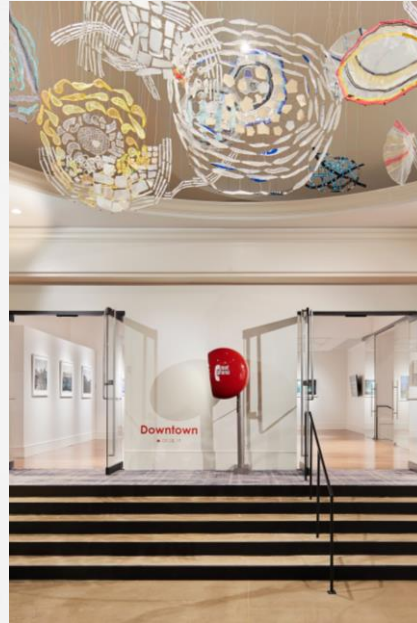

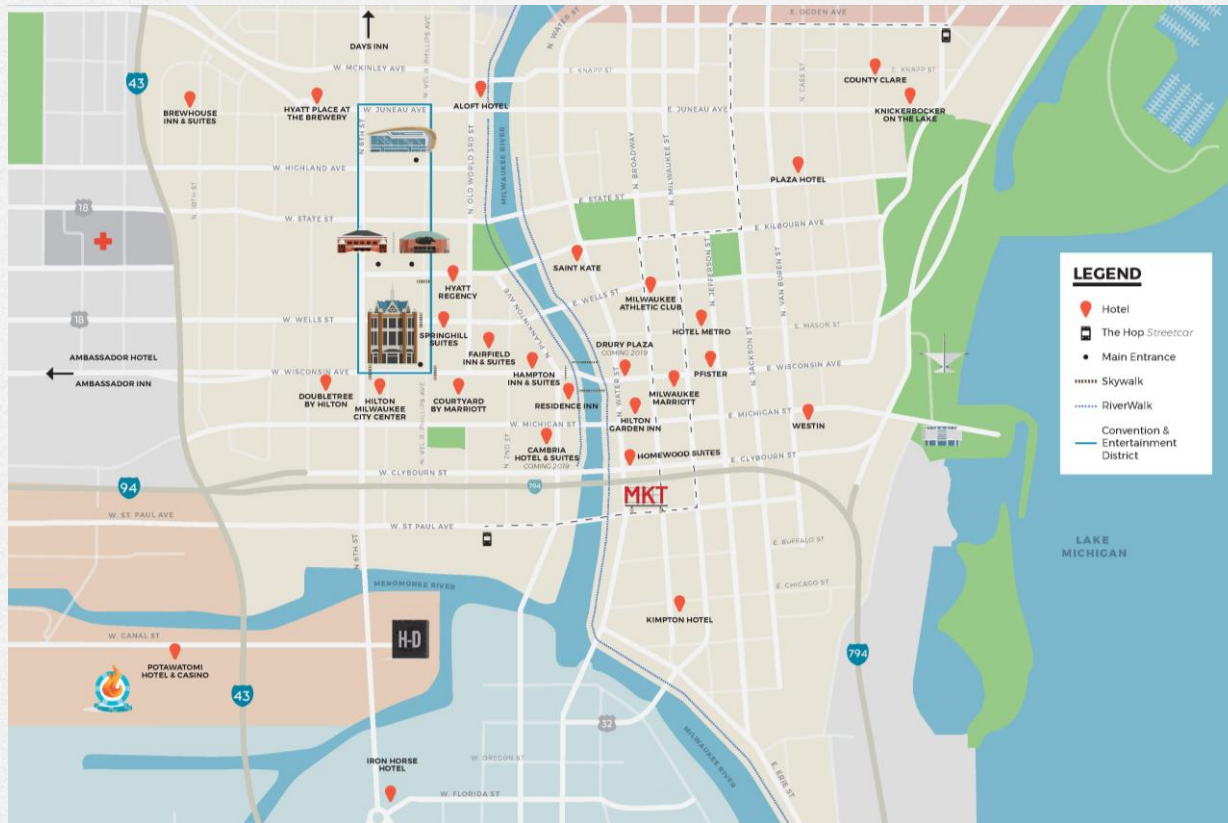
